Happy July and August Everyone!

Thank you all for being such faithful viewers and supporters! The summer is heating up with activities surrounding PBS Michiana-WNIT's 50th year of broadcasting. If you haven't watched, our special program *From Signal to Story: 50 Years of WNIT Public Television* is available to stream from our website: wnit.org/programs/specials.

We're also having events throughout our region. To launch PBS Michiana into the next 50 years, we need to upgrade our production equipment, plus increase the number of local programs. That will take a "few" dollars. We very much appreciate all of you who have been interested in helping. If you would like to hear more about what we are planning, please reach out and I would enjoy visiting with you.

To continue our summer theme, the political climate is heating up. PBS will have extensive coverage of both the Republican and Democratic party conventions. The Republicans go first July 15-18 from Milwaukee, and the Democrats follow August 19-22 from Chicago. You can rely on PBS to provide balanced, objective coverage, analysis and follow-up programs to help your decision making. One such program is *Counting the Vote: Firing Line* which looks into our voting systems, Friday, August 30th at 9pm.

We celebrate our nation's 248th birthday on July 4th, Independence Day. Our most viewed program of the year, *A Capitol Fourth* will broadcast at 8 pm with an encore at 9:30 pm. It's a fabulous program from our nation's capital. After the fireworks, at 11 pm enjoy *Michigan: An American Portrait*.

Crossroads, a brand-new local program premieres on Thursday, July 11th at 7:30pm. This quarterly program roams across Michiana for interesting stories to make you say, "I didn't know that."

We receive a lot of positive feedback when we run programs about local/regional rivers. We're going to devote Thursday evenings in August to these "river stories." Featured rivers will include St. Joseph, Kankakee, Upper Tippecanoe, Grand, Ohio, and more. Check your *Planner* magazine for details.

Two of Ken Burns' more recent documentaries will encore in these next two months. *Benjamin Franklin* will be presented on Fridays July 12th and 19th at 9pm. Then on Thursdays, August 1st and 8th, watch *American Buffalo*. It's hard to beat Ken Burns' storytelling of historical events.

As you know, your *Planner* magazine is loaded with program information and profiles. For example, I bet you'd like to know more about the upcoming *NOVA Special: Sea Change*, or the season premiere of *Magpie Murders*. Keep this *Planner* magazine close by your TV remote for easy reference.
