Why my favorites? Because you also contribute to make our service available to everyone. Thank you for all your support during the year. I hope we are exceeding your expectations!

I have some personal news to share. I am transitioning into retirement. I'm pleased to share that Amanda Miller Kelley, our Director of Development, takes on full responsibilities as President & General Manager on January 1st. She'll be terrific because Amanda knows our communities, knows our viewers / donors, and knows the culture of PBS Michiana-WNIT. Now, let's switch to programming news. January starts with the Season 4 finale of *All Creatures Great and Small* on Sunday, January 5th at 8:30pm. Our *Legends of Michiana* series is extremely popular as we tell stories of our neighbors who have shaped our communities. On Thursday, January 9th, at 8pm, we will feature South Bend's Lynn Coleman. Leonardo was a popular Ken Burns film we brought to you in November. On Friday January 10th, at 9pm, you will enjoy *Behind the Scenes of Leonardo De Vinci with Ken Burns*. *Crossroads* is a quarterly original PBS Michiana-WNIT production of "interesting stories" that we uncover throughout Michiana. Our next episode is Thursday, January 23rd at 7:30pm.

And now, something very special. For only one broadcast, PBS Michiana-WNIT is thrilled to present the *Raffaella Ballet*, featuring the talent of our region's dancers, artists and the South Bend Symphony. This fairytale ballet, we believe, is the largest ballet ever to have originated in Indiana. There's beautiful choreography with 50 dancers, original music, classic sets and costumes, and an outstanding musical performance from the symphony. Enjoy this incredible program on Friday, January 31st at 9pm.

I've been looking forward to this program for over a year. Dr. Henry Louis Gates, Jr., who hosts *Finding Your Roots*, has taken an in-depth look at the migration of African Americans from the South to the North. *Great Migration: A People on the Move*, begins Tuesday, January 28th and runs each Tuesday in February. We will complete the cycle with stories from Michiana with a PBS Michiana-WNIT original *Echoes of the Great Migration: Family Stories of Resilience*, February 18th at 10pm.

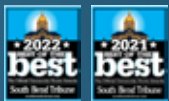
